Editor's Desk.....

Fall is rapidly approaching bringing the usual chores - dividing those large established lily clumps ,transplanting some and sharing the extras with others; checking the fall bulb sales and getting those few lilies you simply could not resist and preparing sites for your new arrivals.

The '99 growing season was unusual for much of the prairies - early warm spring, cool rainy late spring and early summer. Lilies in my garden seemed to be at least two weeks behind in their growth and blooming habit. Stems were shorter than usual, many of the buds aborted or were severely contorted; and insect damage to both buds and leaves was much more noticeable this year. Botrytis was not a problem was not. **Fasciation** occurred in one of the martagon - a first in my garden. Due to the lateness of the season I still had lilies blooming well at the end of August - 'White Henry', 'Northern Beauty','Northern Splendor', 'Skydancer' and 'Pink Champagne'. I do not grow orientals but some are probably in bloom at this time. I was very pleased with the bulbs I bought at "Spring Fling" the annual general meeting - 'Super Nova' and the 'Tetra Trumpet' were stunning; 'Helios', 'Peach Supreme', 'Dawn Delight', 'Cream Longiflorum', 'Misty' and 'Rosepoint Lace' were great. Grass may have to go to accommodate some bulbs in the Fall sale that I will not be able to resist.
