CPLS Show Report 2016

The 50th Annual CPLS Lily Show was held at Lawson Heights Mall, July 22 and 23, 2016.

Exhibitor numbers were up slightly from last year, and stem numbers were also up with 141 stems entered, which is the largest number of stems entered since 2012. This was a bit of a surprise, as the lilies were in bloom much earlier than normal this year and many were finished blooming by show time.

In the Horticulture classes, most of the stems entered were Asiatics, which is typical. As was the case last year, due to the lateness of the show, there were no Martagon stems entered. There were many interdivisionals, which were mostly LA's, as well as a few trumpets and OT's. In Section H (three stem collections) there were six entries, which was the same as last year.

Judges for the Horticulture Sections were Margaret Driver and Allan Daku. Clerks for Horticulture were Sharon Newton and Hilda Noton.

The Floral Design Section looked awesome again this year, with some great entries from very talented designers! There were 19 entries in this section from four exhibitors. The Judge for Floral Design was Bonny Lundberg, clerk was Barb Adams Eichendorf.

The Photography classes had several more entries than last year, with 23 entries from four exhibitors. The judge for the Photography classes was Glen Grambo. Glen made a record of the winners, and filled out a comment sheet. Only 26 ballots were cast for the Peoples' Choice award, so we're planning to create more signage to encourage people to vote. Hopefully this will increase participation.

Thanks so much to everyone who helped with all of the tasks required to run the show. Margaret Driver did classification as well as the publicity and the TV spot with CTV. Sharon Newton, Janice Peace, Len Donauer and I looked after getting the show set up on Thursday. Sale and clean up was handled by Karen Sawchyn, Janice Peace, Sharon Newton, Irwin and Luella Gatzke, Shirley Wisemiller, Suzanne Beaubien, Tara Leibel, Len Donauer and myself.
